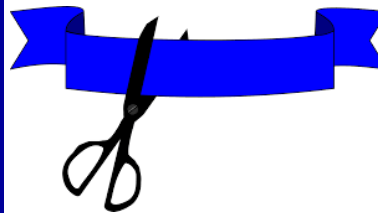

MIACC Foundation Artificial Reef Module

The Marine Industries Association of Collier County Foundation will purchase a reef module, part of the Artificial Reef Fund in Southwest Florida. The MIACC announced that funds of \$2,500 were raised through donations by its members. This donation will gain the MIACC Foundation naming rights to a module reef, part of the 36-reef deployment.

The Artificial Reef program was born when long time Southwest Florida angler and local attorney, Peter Flood joined with Economic Recovery Task Force to realize a dream towards significant ecological opportunities and economic development along the Paradise Coast. Development efforts in Southwest Florida tend to focus along the coastline and inland, not within its waters. Artificial reefs hold the key to a healthy ecosystem and a recovering economy here in Collier County.

The plan is to deploy 36 artificial reefs off the Coast of Collier County. Within two hours life begins to form around the artificial reef structures. Within two years a reef is fully mature. When properly sited and constructed, artificial reefs will create species habitats, estuary enhancement, recreational diving and fishing opportunities, and barriers to protect endangered species and habitats.

The 8' Florida Limestone artificial reef module is a habitat for fish and marine life. It is a 6,000 lb. concrete structure built to withstand storm events. It has a 10' footprint designed to prevent settling and scouring. The limestone rock gives it a greater surface area and complexity which attracts marine life.

A tentative date for deployment of the reefs is scheduled for the week of December 8th. The Marine Industries Association of Collier County Foundation would like to thank the donors to the reef module fundraiser: Boater's Landing, Coastal Angler Magazine, Naples Harbour, Rose Marina, SeaTech Marine Electronics, and Valerie Pike. The MIACC is proud to be a part of marine life history in Southwest Florida for the next 800 years!

The majority of the sailors travel from in state, and we have also attracted sailors from Wisconsin, Michigan, Louisiana, Georgia & New York. The Naples Cup offers racing for several classes of boats, the largest class being the youth optimist class.

The NCSC team has become the elite racing team in Florida! Our club regularly posts top-ten finishes in almost every class and, this past summer, we sent sailors to international regattas as representatives of the U.S. team. The youth racing team typically travels to more than 20 regattas each year, competing in New York, Annapolis, New Orleans and throughout Florida. The sailors who race expect to spend no less than ten hours each week in "on the water" practice and during a regatta, they are in their boats for about six hours each day. The regimen is demanding and the benefits are huge! Our sailors develop **CONFIDENCE, LEADERSHIP, RESPONSIBILITY AND INDEPENDENCE**, all skills that set these youth apart from their peers, both on the water and in everyday life.
