Contest Rules & Guidelines

- Grades 4th – 8th
- One entry per student
- A minimal use of text is suggested.
- A diverse range of media will be accepted, including drawing, painting, collage.
- Artwork must be original and created by the student between August 1, 2022 – December 1, 2022.
- Artwork must be between 8-9" tall and 10-11" wide and less than 1/4" thick.
- Artwork must not contain any inappropriate content.
