Marine Safety & Security Forum Recap

- ♦ Education is most important to boater safety
- The best life jacket you can buy is the one you will wear! Being tossed from the boat can happen in an instant and it's hard to float if you're seriously injured or unconscious.
- ♦ Don't drink and boat!
- Don't let kids or guests sit on the bow or sides of a boat even at idle speed. A prop can strike 160x a second
- ♦ Be courteous! Watch your wake
- When you sell a vessel be sure to go with the buyer to transfer the title
- ♦ The more steps to deter boat theft the better!
 - ♦ Light is a big deterrent!
 - Hidden switch for lifts and engines
 - ♦ Fuel cut off switch
 - Don't leave your keys or equipment on the boat!
- If keeping your boat at a storage facility, check their security protocols. Don't keep it parked in the back
- Suggested Security Devices:
 - ♦ Geo fence
 - ♦ Ring camera with light
 - ♦ Titanium chain/lock
 - GPS tracking (keep in mind, GPS can be jammed by anti tracking devices)
- Write down the serial numbers of vessel, electronics and equipment

- ♦ Take photos of equipment, rods, vessel, etc
- Thieves will preop for months before a hit. Get and save a photo of suspicious persons.
- Share information!!! Police don't mind tips. Even if you think it's nothing. Share it. It could be a missing piece to an investigation.

- ♦ The New Floating Fuel Dock is located at the end of the boat lift dock (aka the "T-Dock") and will serve as the PRIMARY FUEL DOCK for all marina customers. The outside face of the fuel dock is 95' long with several heavy duty cleats. There are two smaller fueling slips on the inside of the main fuel dock that can accommodate smaller vessels (40' or less with max. beam of 13'). The dock features 4 dispensers: two non-ethanol gasoline nozzles, a standard flow diesel nozzle, and a high flow diesel nozzle capable of 30 Gallons Per Minute (the high flow nozzle is I" in diameter, all other nozzles are 3/4"). All hoses are 100' in length. The dock is also equipped with waste pump out. The Fuel Dock is not self service, a staff member must be present. Hail Rose Marina on VHF 09 to request fuel or pump out.
- Captain's Cabana Opens! This new facility houses men's and women's restrooms, showers, laundry and a small lounge for mariners to handle the occasional voyage office duties, hold



Captain's meetings or to simply take a break from the heat with a favorite beverage (BYO). The "Captain's Cabana" stands in place of the original 1966 dockmasters office, in the heart of the marina.

- I. Core Web Vitals: A combination of three key performance metrics Largest Contentful Paint, First Input Delay, and Cumulative Layout Shift that measure the visual loading, interactivity, and visual stability of pages on your website as it loads for users.
- 2. Mobile-Friendliness: Looks at how easy your website is to use and navigate on mobile devices, including the readability of content and whether links and on-page elements are clickable and accessible. That includes the Call-to-Actions as well, such as phone numbers, buttons, etc....
- 3. Safe Browsing: Assesses whether your website has issues such as malware, phishing, and hacked content, to ensure that users can browse safely.
- 4. HTTPS: Focuses on whether the connection of your website is secure and if the site is being served over HTTPS as recommended or not.
- 5. Non-Intrusive Interstitials: Ensures that crucial on-page content is not obstructed for users as they are browsing.
